


Tarot and the Psyche

Join Jungian Analyst Joseph Lee for a soulful weekend exploring the mysteries of the tarot and its relevance to psychological development.

The rich archetypal images of the Tarot can offer us insights into the powerful unconscious forces that shape the intersubjective field and the unfolding psyche. Gaining insights into these subtle psychological forces can help us align with emerging creativity and become aware of unconscious blocks.

To interpret a tarot image at a deep level one must understand its underlying structure – the Kabbalistic Tree of Life. When the relationship between Tarot and Kabbalah is understood, one experiences the images as specific nuanced expressions of the central Self. We begin to intuit the multiple psychospiritual factors in a given moment as a mysteriously coordinated dance. This synthetic attitude helps to link the disparate images into a cohesive living system.

Applying this experience of the animated ocean of images to an individual situation is what the ancients called *reading the Liber Mundi*. We will approach this through a unique process of interpreting various lay-outs of tarot cards as Jungian dynamics.

Context provides a frame of meaning which allows us to not simply *know* something but to *understand* it and imagine its application and varieties of expression. We will frame the synchronistic lay-out of Tarot images in four contexts: The Shadow, The Ego, The Self and The Telos. This Jungian approach will help us understand the active forces at play in the individual psyche at a given juncture.

To honor the tradition of *mouth-to-ear* instruction and offer ample opportunity for individual support this program is limited to 12 participants.

In this workshop participants will:

- Explore the cosmology of the Kabbalistic Tree of Life as the underlying structure of the 78 Tarot cards.
- Gain insights into the Jungian structure of The Shadow (personal unconscious material), The Ego (conscious personal attitude or stance in life), The Self (the transpersonal or archetypal forces) and The Telos (the trajectory).

- Learn to use a deck of Tarot Cards to foster a deeper understanding of self and others in a personal or clinical setting.

The Facilitator

Joseph R. Lee is a Jungian Analyst in private practice in Virginia Beach VA, the president of the CG Jung Institute of Philadelphia & The Philadelphia Association of Jungian Analysts, and co-creator of This Jungian Life podcast. He lectures nationally on Hermetic Kabbalah with a focus on reinterpreting the ancient ideas in modern idioms.
